Broadband Options for Walton-in-Gordano: Many of you will know that broadband signals in much of the parish are appallingly slow. Walton-in-Gordano does not fall into the area where BT are installing super-fast broadband, nor is there a likelihood that they will in the future - we appear to fall into that fateful 5%! There are alternatives that individual homes can install - for example fast broadband via satellite if you subscribe to Sky. Without getting technical, other alternatives require a minimum number of committed subscribers - typically 40-60 - to be viable. If you might be interested in joining a group scheme, please e-mail the Clerk with your address to register that interest. There will be no commitment at this stage, but providers need to be assured that enough homes are at least interested - and where those homes are - before they will commit to tailoring a provision and providing quotes.
