PARISH COUNCIL

Parish Council Elections: There were 3 Parish Council nominations to fill 5 vacancies; there will, therefore, be no May 2015 Parish Council election. In due course, the 2 remaining vacancies will be advertised for nomination. There will then be an election if there are more than two nominations arising from that advertisement. If, after this advertising process, any vacancies remain, the Council will be free to co-opt applicants to fill those vacancies.

Parish Council Annual General Meeting: The next meeting will be at 7PM, in the Village Hall, on Monday May 11th. This will be the Annual General Meeting, at which the Chair, Vice Chair, and Representatives to Outside Bodies are elected by Members.

Annual Parish Meeting: The Annual Parish Meeting will be held at **8pm**, in the Village Hall, on Monday May 11th, immediately following the Parish Council meeting. This is not a Parish Council meeting, but an open meeting, which all residents of Walton-in-Gordano Civil Parish are able to attend and to take part in. As usual, the meeting will receive reports from key parish activity groups. There will also be an open discussion on the proposed Walton Street 20mph speed limit - its practicalities and costs, and an open discussion session at which any resident is able to raise any parish-related topic they wish.

Walton Street Road Closure Notice: Walton Street will be closed - for work by Bristol Water - for 1 day. The exact date will be confirmed later, but will probably be **May 27th** 2015. The full notice is at waltoningordanopc.org.uk.

Cycle Race: On May 31st there will be a Cycle Race, as part of the Portishead Triathlon, that will include The Coast Road, Walton Street, and the B3124 towards Portishead. Preparation for this has been much more thorough than in previous years, but if anyone has cause for complaint about the conduct of the race, or its competitors, you may contact the organiser, Garga Chamberlain, on 07702 410797
